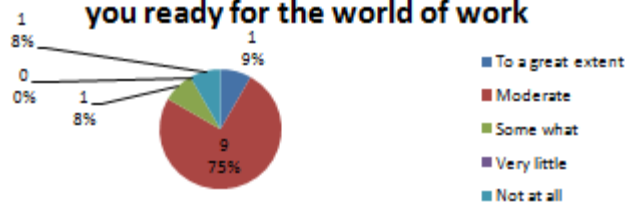

DEPARTMENT STRENGTH:

- ❖ Students are satisfied with the teaching of Illustrations on programming logics and concepts through real-time examples and applications.
- ❖ Students are trained with the higher-end configured computer systems during the practical sessions, so that we are able to give exposure with latest system environment.
- ❖ Organizing students meet with teachers regularly to identify their needs on academic matters and requirements inside the college campus.
- ❖ Providing e-materials on various topics ,for the subject in which they are finding difficult to learn.
- ❖ Allowing the students to collect real-time sample data from various industries for their project development.
