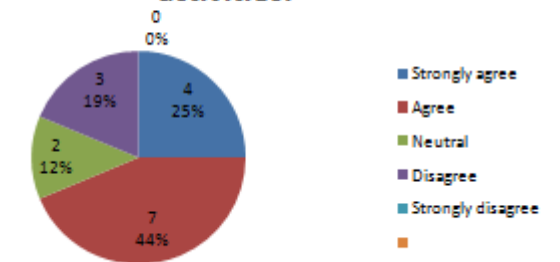
The teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications



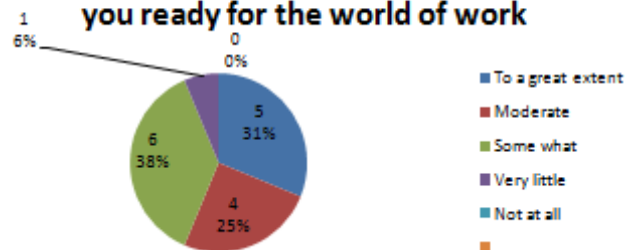

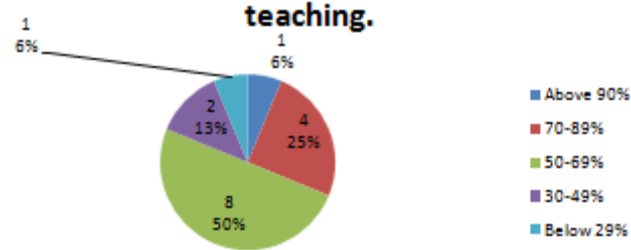

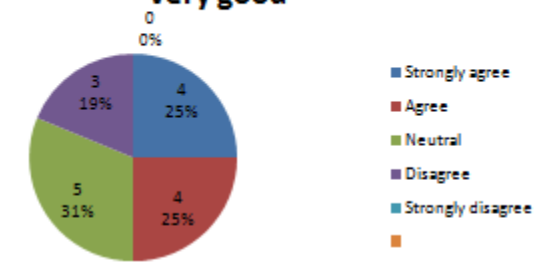
