I begin this annual report by extending our heartfelt congratulations to our esteemed retired faculty members: Prof. S. Chellapandian, Dr. S. Dinakaran, Dr. S. Muthukumar, and Dr. R. Saravanan, who retired in the academic year 2023-2024. I also acknowledge the impending retirement of Dr. K. Neyvasagam, Dr. Pandiselvi, and Dr. M. Premarani in the current academic year 2024-2025. Their dedication and specialized contributions to our institution will always be cherished and remembered. I wish them all the best in their well-deserved retirement and pray that they are blessed with a peaceful, happy, and healthy life ahead.

Academics & related activities

A total of 564 students have been admitted this year, with 477 students graduating. The college currently boasts a total enrolment of 1234 students in the aided stream.

I am pleased to announce that the UGC has granted our college autonomous status for an additional 10 years, extending until 2035.

In line with our commitment to providing quality education, we have decided to introduce new programs in the Self-Finance stream. These include B.Com with Computer Application, B.Sc in Computer Science with AI & Data Science specialization, and an additional section for B.Sc. Computer Science. The Commission has conducted a visit to the college, and we are now awaiting approval from MKU.

New Initiatives – Infra-Structure Developments

Srimathi Renganayaki Sri Narasimachariar Hall (Second Floor): *On the first floor of Hall twelve classrooms, one lab and two staff rooms have been constructed and opened for the use of SF-wing students starting this academic year. Construction of classrooms on the second floor is currently underway and is scheduled to be completed for the next academic year.*

Additionally, a fully-equipped dormitory has been built, complete with eight cricket practice pitches, in collaboration with TNCA. This facility will cater to young individuals looking to enhance their cricket skills and develop their gaming abilities.

Regular Activities

The Student Council convenes monthly meetings to provide students with a platform to voice their concerns and suggestions to the administration. Additionally, the College Council and Department Heads hold monthly meetings to deliberate on both academic and non-academic activities in order to achieve the institution's objectives.

Feedback received from students is shared with faculty members to identify their strengths and weaknesses, ultimately enhancing their academic performance. The college administration values the input provided by students and is committed to upholding the esteemed reputation of Madura College by prioritizing the needs of its primary stakeholders, the students.
