To finalize the course design for implementation of inter-disciplinary / multi-disciplinary courses in all programmes.	Inter-Disciplinary Courses for UG programmes during V semester and Multi-Disciplinary Courses for PG programmes during III semester were introduced from the academic year 2022-23 (Passed in the Academic Council held on 20-07-2022).
To identify peer institutions for cluster formation for sharing of expertise and infrastructure.	Formulation of methodology under progress and deferred to forthcoming year.

All the staff members were divided into six groups to discuss the various themes related to NEP-2020. After discussion, the group leaders presented the outcome of the discussion with their team members. A draft policy (subject to directions from Govt. of Tamilnadu) was formulated.</p>

To encourage departments / Cells to sign MoUs with organizations towards Academics and Student Support activities.	A total of 9 MoUs were signed during 2021-22 for carrying out academic and student support activities in collaboration with external agencies.
To create awareness among students about MOOC courses and to organize Registration Drives. Also, to encourage students to opt for credit transfer.	One student availed credit transfer from SWAYAM course against NME. Efforts shall be taken to enhance the number of students taking up MOOC courses for availing credit transfer.
To encourage departments to enhance uptake of internship / field projects by students. Students opting for internship shall be considered for exemption from submission against one of the components of internal assessment. It is also suggested that students projects shall be made mandatory for all programmes.	A total of 473 students have undergone internship / field projects during the academic year 2021-22 from various departments.
To automate attainment calculation for OBE based on "Manual of outcome attainment".	The draft manual of outcome attainment is passed in the Academic Council held on 20-07-2022. Automation of the same is under process.
To Conduct Academic and Administrative Audit.	Academic and Administrative Audit was conducted on 23-10-2021. Dr. M.G. Sethuraman, Professor of Chemistry, The Gandhigram Rural Institute,

	Gandhigram, Dindigul and Dr. B. Vanitha, Former Registrar, Bharathiar University, Coimbatore were the external auditors. The report of the audit was forwarded to the Principal for necessary course correction.
To conduct Library Audit.	Library Audit was conducted on 19-05-2022. Dr. C. Sujatha, Librarian, Department of Library and Information Centre, Fatima College (Autonomous), Madurai was the external auditor. The report of the audit was forwarded to the Principal for necessary course correction.
