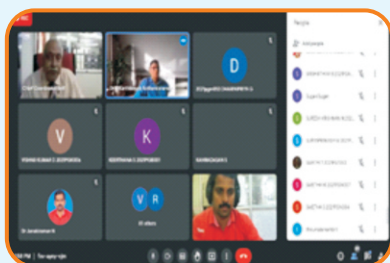
### Bose-Einstein Club-Science Exhibition

Department of Physics organized the science exhibition 2022 on 07/04/2022 and 08/04/2022 at Madura College. A total of 32 students participated and exhibited various models.

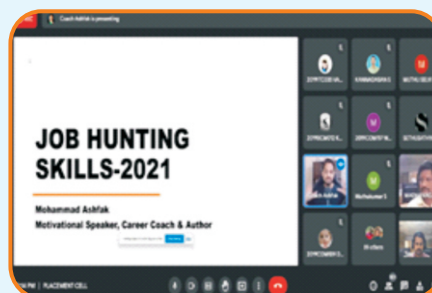
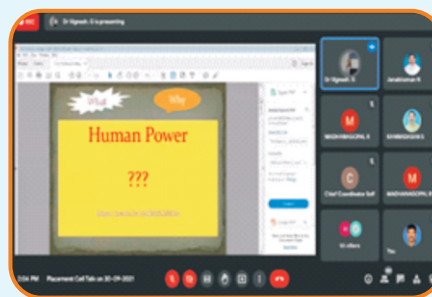

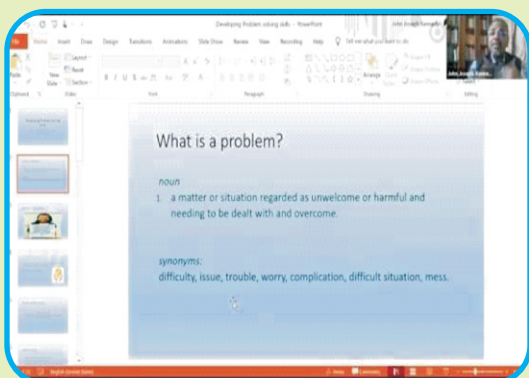
### PLACEMENT CELL
